
Then to celebrate Pastor Nikki's arrival, come July 2nd to introduce yourself.



Welcome to the Trustees' Corner

Well, we snuck downstairs to get the latest peek at the renovation process. Over a few weeks' span, the General Contractor had the cement floors cut out in different directions to prepare for the plumbing subcontractors to come and start laying new pipes for water and sewage. It is amazing that through each step along the way they keep uncovering more history. While cutting through the cement floors, sandstone blocks were discovered in different areas. The entire cement floor in the kitchen has been removed, exposing even more of the base of the support columns in that area of the building. Majority of the demo part is coming to an end. It will be a matter of time before the subcontractors will be on site working on the new electrical and plumbing. By the time the July/August issue of the *Circuit Rider* comes out, we will have a lot more updates for you. We are grateful for all the gifts given thus far towards the Capital Campaign; any additional giving in your heart would be greatly appreciated to help make up for the difference between the project cost of

\$1.9 million and the \$730k available funds from current giving. Be sure to stay tuned each month and read our article.




Visit the Library!






Visitation may seem scary. Even if you know the person you are visiting, their situation or a change in health may make you uncomfortable. Visiting in pairs or in family groups may alleviate some of the uncertainty. Having additional information or training could also help with visitor anxiety or trepidation.

Yet we are each called to Christian visitation – to care for those who are ill or lonely or apart. Many of our members that are homebound or in the hospital are anxious for a visit to 'catch up' on church happenings and people. Training sessions will be offered in the fall, but visitations can begin this summer when children are out of school. Can you give an hour once a month to visit one or two homebound members, or to perhaps call them on the phone or send them a card?
